And thank you to the Mayor of Dudley, who will be introducing our charity raffle, which brings the day's programme to a close.



## **Cradley Health Model Railway Club**





#### **Blackbrook Halt**

Set in the 1960s, this fictional Black Country vard served a ship anchor foundry, with Pannier tanks from Stourbridge and a rarely used halt linking two lines.



#### **Halfpenny Green**

Opened in 1925, the Wombourne branch line was intended to reach Bridgnorth but halted at Halfpenny Green.



#### The Basin

Set in 1920s eastern England, the layout is a snapshot of a post war industrial area, where the railway served the canal and local industries.

#### **Cwm Hir**

Inspired by Welsh narrowgauge railways, Cwm Hir portrays a rural Powys line from a century ago.

#### Gibben Ouarry

Gibben Quarry is a fictitious rural station with an offscene stone quarry, there are sidings for wagons in and out and a tower for loading stone into wagons.








#### Victoria Bridae

Victoria Bridge is an N Gauge working diorama of the iconic Severn Valley Railway bridge. Trains range from heritage favourites to modern stock, including luxury dining cars and the Class 139 from Stourbridge.

#### **Sainte Marie**

Built in just a month, this layout began on 27 August 2023 with only an empty baseboard and a vision.
Set in 1960s Sainte Marie, a fictional village in southeast France, it can also represent the 1980s with minor changes to vehicles, figures, and details like Le Tour de France.



#### St Michael's Town

A typical small town in western USA depicting an American narrow-gauge line. The layout was designed by Paul Walton and was built with help from other BMRC members including Andrew Weaver and Therese Weaver.



#### What's On TV?

A micro layout built inside a vintage TV set with several small modules built by members of the Birmingham model railway club to allow us to (change channel).







#### **Tehachet Butte F&Cry**

A H0e American narrow gauge micro layout built on a cake board, built by 009 society and Birmingham model railway club member Paul Walton.



#### 00 Gauge Bicycle Wheel

A unique layout with a loop of 00-gauge track inside a bicycle wheel that allows the weight of the locomotive to turn the wheel.



#### Yn Nodi Pren

A typical Welsh narrowgauge railway depicting a small station in a forest with many hidden animals to find. The layout is named in memory of Andrew's late father Mark Weaver, Yn Nodi Pren is the Welsh translation of Marks Wood.














## **Luncheon Junction**






## **TRAM 16**








